Experience the vibrant soul of Nagaland on a 5-day cultural and nature journey combining the iconic Hornbill Festival, the heritage village of Khonoma, which is considered as the greenest village of Asia, the serene mountain village of Dzuleke, known for its amazing natural beauty and reserves, and the cultural heart of Kohima, the capital of Nagaland. From the authentic village life and warm hospitality of Dzuleke to the historic landscapes of Khonoma, this trip every day offers a glimpse into Nagaland's rich traditions and breathtaking mountain scenery. The highlight of the journey is a full day at the Hornbill Festival in Kisama, where the diverse Naga tribes come together through traditional dances, music, indigenous games, crafts, food, and celebrations. With scenic drives through the Naga Hills, traditional homestays, local experiences and time to explore Kohima, this trip is designed for travellers who want to experience Nagaland beyond the usual tourist trail—immersing themselves in its people, culture, landscapes and stories. A journey of mountains, tribes, traditions and unforgettable experiences—Nagaland awaits.

- **Experience the Hornbill Festival** - Witness Nagaland's iconic "**Festival of Festivals**" at **Kisama**.

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 | DIMAPUR – DZULEKE – Pickup from **Dimapur** Railway Station and drive through the scenic Naga Hills to **Dzuleke**. Check in at the homestay and explore the peaceful village and surrounding countryside, experiencing authentic Naga village life and hospitality. Overnight stay at **Dzuleke**.

DAY 2 | DZULEKE – KHONOMA – KOHIMA – KIGWEMA – After breakfast, drive to **Khonoma** and explore its historic **Angami village**, traditional settlements and scenic landscapes and traditional paddy fields in the village. Continue to **Kohima** for sightseeing, covering the War Cemetery, Catholic Cathedral and local market. Later, drive to **Kigwema**, check in and relax amidst the beautiful Naga Hills. Overnight stay at **Kigwema**.

DAY 3 | PULIEBADZE – KOHIMA – KIGWEMA – After breakfast, head to **Puliebadze** for a short hike and enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding Naga Hills. Continue exploring **Kohima**, including local markets and cultural spots, before returning to Kigwema by evening. Overnight stay at **Kigwema**.

DAY 4 | KIGWEMA – KISAMA – After breakfast, head to **Kisama Heritage Village** for a full day at the **Hornbill Festival** – the “**Festival of Festivals**.” Experience vibrant tribal performances, traditional Morungs, indigenous games, handicrafts and authentic Naga cuisine. By evening return to **Kigwema** by evening. Overnight stay at **Kigwema**.

DAY 5 | KIGWEMA – DIMAPUR – After breakfast, drive back to **Dimapur** through the scenic Naga Hills. Arrive at Dimapur Railway Station and conclude your memorable Nagaland journey. Trip Ends.
